# To support its growth, the Apave Group announces the recruitment of 2,500 new employees by 2025, including 1,700 in France

Hundreds of professions working for a safer, more sustainable world

Paris, 23 January 2025. In a world facing deep challenges, Apave groupe, an international specialist in the management of technical, environmental, human and digital risks, has been continuing to expand rapidly in France and around the world, with 25 strategic acquisitions since 2020.

With a presence in 60 countries and a workforce of 17,500 people, the Group is reaffirming its commitment to the safety of people and equipments with an objective to recruit a total of 2,500 employees by 2025 (mostly permanent contracts), including 1,700 in France, to help companies and local authorities make the transition to safer, more responsible practices.

This recruitment plan is part of a dynamic of sustained growth in France and internationally, and also offers many opportunities for mobility within the Group.

- Training missions: to provide training in workplace safety and occupational risks, and to reduce occupational accidents in companies of all sizes.
- ► Certification and labelling missions: to audit structures committed to applying standards or voluntary benchmarks and enable them to promote their commitments.
- ► Consultancy and technical support: to assist our customers with their day-to-day needs or those specifically linked to a project or critical situation.

In recent years, Apave has developed specific expertise to provide cross-disciplinary support for current issues:

- Sustainability: Apave supports companies in meeting their sustainability challenges, through consultancy and certification assignments via its dedicated subsidiary RSE France, authorised by the French High Audit Authority (H2A) to carry out verifications of Sustainability / CSRD Reports.
- ▶ **Digital**: Apave, through its subsidiary Apave Digital, provides consultancy and training in cybersecurity and data protection, as well as certification via LSTI.


